WHAT HAPPENS AT THE CLUB WHEN.....?

HRSB make the announcements as close to 6:00 am as possible.

As per BGCGRH PROGRAM GUIDELINES, an announcement could be;

CLUB OPENINGS / CLOSINGS

The Boys and Girls Clubs of Greater Halifax sites follows Halifax Regional School Board;

- A. **Storm Days;** When media broadcasts that Halifax Regional School Board Schools are closed then **ALL 6 SITES** of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Halifax will be **CLOSED**.
- B. **Programs/Services;** may be cancelled due to inclement weather and will be done at the discretion of Club management.
- C. When all the Halifax Regional School Board Schools are open but school buses (Stock Transportation) are cancelled (due to inclement weather or poor road conditions) then the **CLUBS ARE CLOSED. No service at any Site.**
- D. When schools are in session and inclement weather causes a mid-day closure of Halifax Regional School Board schools then the Boys and Girls Club will conduct regular operations (i.e. pick-up of students who are registered in the after school program excluding Humber Park). If severe weather conditions persist parents will be contacted to pick up members immediately so that everyone can get home safely. Special events or activities may be cancelled due to weather (i.e. swim, sports programs, etc.).
- E. All schools are delayed in opening by 2 hours;
ED & ND sites CLOSED for Early Morning programs. All 6 sites will open and operate After School programs.
